have been learning about weight. We

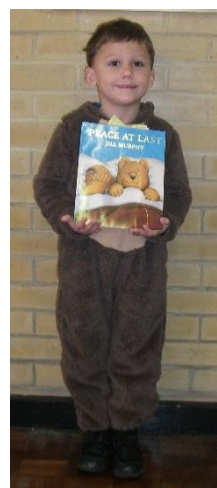


recapped the language 'heavy, light, heavier, lighter, heaviest and lightest'
