CONTACT BOOKS (Reading Records)

- **Contact books should be handed in every day, with home reading recorded in them.**
- **You can also use the books to write messages to us if needed.**
- **If you have written a message please ask your child to show it to us when they arrive at school – otherwise it may not be seen until late in the school day.**

P.E. KIT

- **P.E. will be on Mondays and Thursdays.**
- **Blue P.E. t-shirt, blue or black shorts, plimsolls or trainers for outside, bare feet or plimsolls for inside.**
- **Tracksuits or sweatshirts (blue or black) may be worn when cold. Sweatshirts should not have a hood.**
- **Hair tied back, no jewellery.**
- **If your child is unable to take part in P.E., please send in a note to explain why.**
- **Children who do not have their P.E. kit will be asked to fill in a non-participation form, and a letter will go home.**

HOMework

- One piece of English/Topic and Maths every week.
- To be handed out on a Friday.
- To be handed back in by Tuesday.
- Maths homework will usually be Maths Whizz.
- Research will occasionally be set to assist with class learning.
- Children also need to be reading every night, and practising times tables (including division facts).

Ways to help your child at home

- **Times table practice.**
- **Regular reading.**
- **Learn the spellings from the lists in the middle of your contact book.**
- **Ensuring homework is completed and handed in on time – including Maths Whizz.**
- **Visits to library to research topics.**
- **When using internet research, aid children in finding key points.**
- **Visit places of interest.**

SATS TESTS 2016

- **The tests will be on Maths and English, as in previous years, but on the content of the New Curriculum.**
- **Reporting on the outcomes of the tests will be different to previous years, as levels have now been discontinued.**
