We will be learning to...

- -build constructive and respectful relationships
- -express our feelings and consider the feelings of others

Mathematics

We will be learning to...

- -Know that the last number reached when counting objects tells you how many there are in total
- -link numerals to amounts up to 5
- -experiment with their own symbols and marks
- -compare quantities using more than, fewer than,
- -Subitise
- -talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes
- -understand position through words alone

Physical Development

We will be learning to ...

- -use one handed tools and equipment
- -use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils
- -know and talk about the different factors that support our overall health and wellbeing
- -be increasingly independent as we get dressed

Communication and Language

We will be learning to ...

- -understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important
- -learn new vocabulary
- -articulate their ideas in well-formed sentences
- -describe events in some detail
- -listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding
- -use new vocabulary in different contexts
- -listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge

Literacy

We will be learning to ...

- -engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- -use some of our print and letter knowledge in our early writing
- -write some or all of our name
- -write some letters accurately
- -read individual letters by saying the sounds
- -blend sounds into words
- -spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letters

Understanding the World

We will be learning to...

- -show interest in different occupations
- -plant seeds and care for growing plants
- -compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past
- -recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways
- -recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to...

- -develop complex stories using small world equipment
- -make imaginative and complex small worlds with blocks and construction kits
- -explore different materials freely
- -develop our own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them
