- find solutions to conflicts and rivalries
- talk with others to solve conflicts
- be increasingly independent as we get dressed and undressed
- build constructive and respectful relationships
- express our feelings and consider the feelings of others

Physical Development

We will be learning to ...

- use one handed tools and equipment
- use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils
- know and talk about the different factors that support our overall health and wellbeing
- be increasingly independent as we get dressed

Communication and Language

We will be learning to ...

- understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important
- learn new vocabulary
- articulate their ideas in well-formed sentences
- describe events in some detail
- listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding
- use new vocabulary in different contexts
- listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge

Our Pride Values

A pride value is a principle that guides our thinking and behaviour. We celebrate when children demonstrate these values and promote them through all that we do.

Our definition of respect: Respect means caring for other people, places and property.

Mathematics

We will be learning to...

- Know that the last number reached when counting objects tells you how many there are in total
- link numerals to amounts up to 5
- experiment with their own symbols and marks
- compare quantities using more than, fewer than,
- Subitise
- talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes
- understand position through words alone

Literacy

We will be learning to ...

- engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- use some of our print and letter knowledge in our early writing
- write some or all of our name
- write some letters accurately
- read individual letters by saying the sounds
- blend sounds into words
- spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letters
