Actions and next steps from us:

Based on your feedback following the parent survey and parent forum, the school will take the following actions:

Improve Behaviour & Antibullying Work

- A small minority of parents have raised bullying as an issue in some year groups; we take this very seriously and have a robust behaviour policy in place.
- We have an open-door policy and actively encourage all parents to speak with the class teacher on the first instance. If further support is needed, parents must seek the appropriate channels to further escalate- the Phase or year group leader, Assistant heads- Mrs Farell/Mrs Johnson, Deputy head- Mr Tate and Headteacher-Mrs Wall.

Strengthen Communication

- **Parent forums** We welcome more opportunities for parents to communicate with us and will open up parent forums to support this - Thank you to those who attended on 7th May. The next parent forum will take place **online on Thursday 25th June 2.00-3.00.**
- We recognised that some aspects of communication have not been timely or accurate, particularly communication via the school website or email. As a senior leadership team, over the next term we will take action to rectify this by strengthening our communication systems and procedures. We will ensure that information is clear, accurate and consistent.
- We will improve the timeliness of updates through regular monitoring by SLT and clearer lines of responsibility such as class teacher or senior leader checking if the information has been sent.
- Provide further feedback to parents on how to support their child with learning key concepts such as 'number bonds' and provide worked examples to support.
- Key dates to be added to SWAY to support easy access for parents to see the week ahead.

- Timely communication regarding changed to P.E days- email from class teacher in advance.

Expand Clubs, Activities & Enrichment

- Review clubs to ensure **all year groups**, including Year 3 and Year 2, have options during lunchtime or afterschool options across the week.
- We will review the yearly overview of special days, events and fun opportunities to ensure there is a balance- with a focus on chosen charity selected by school council.

Parents' Evenings

- We review the scheduling of parents evening appointments and allocation of time.
