# Where Children Come First

#### **PSHE**

This term we will be exploring relationships. We will be learning about:

- Healthy and happy relationships
- Who is special to us
- How we care for other people
- What is appropriate and inappropriate types of contact

#### <u>Art</u>

This term in Art we will be creating our own seascape collage.

- We will look at seascape collages from various artists
- We will learn some collage techniques
- We will create our own seascapes based on a seaside we know.

This term, we will listen to and appraise different styles of music, play instruments, sing, compose and perform.

#### Place Value to 100

#### Time

We will learn how to tell the time to an hour and half an hour on an analogue clock.

#### **Computing**

This term we will be coding and will learn:

- To use code to make a computer program
- To understand what an event is
- To use an event to control an object

#### **Religious Education**

This term we will be answering the question 'What happens in a Mosque?

- We will be learning about mosques and what features they have
- We will be learning the important features of a mosque
- What is Wudu?
- What is Salat ?

This term we are answering the question 'What are plants?' and will be:
