English

Holes by Louis Sachar

This term we will use the story 'Holes', about a young boy sent to Camp green lake, a correctional boot camp after being falsely accused of theft as an inspiration for our writing. We will focus on writing:

- Setting descriptions using fronted adverbials and figurative language.
- Formal and informal letters using parenthesis, considering different authorial voice.
- A narrative flashback story using speech and varied sentence types.

Geography

By answering the question 'How and why are resources transported across the globe?' the children will develop their:

- Understanding of how globalisation has changed the way that we communicate, and that developments in technology have been the biggest facilitator of this change
- Locational knowledge of other countries around the world that the UK trades with, with an emphasis on where our clothes and food come from.

<u>P.E.</u>

Physical

In this unit, the children will develop the skill of jumping and landing in different directions and on one and two legs and apply this to a game setting.

<u>DT</u>

This term children will be learning about food technology. This will link to their science learning about the importance of a healthy and balanced diet, and to their geography learning about globalisation and it's impact on the availability of ingredients. They will also learn about the importance of good food hygiene practices.
