The Queen's Nose by Dick King-Smith

This term we will reading the story 'The Queen's Nose'. This story is about a 10 year old girl, who is given a 50p coins, which will grant her 7 wishes. We will be focusing on writing newspaper reports:

- Writing 2 reports based on the outcomes following 2 of the main characters wishes.
- The features of newspaper reports.
- In SPAG, using commas and apostrophes for possession.

History

By answering the question 'How was life like for the people in the ancient civilisations?' the children will develop their:

- Historical enquiry skills, by looking at images of artefacts from these civilizations.
- Ability to identify changes within and between different civilizations.
- Skills in make comparisons between elements of ancient civilizations.

This term the children will be learning to play handball, improving their skills of:

<u>Art</u>

This term we are using clay to make 3D clay pots based on our learning in history of Ancient Civilizations and the contempory artist Kate Malone.
