By reading, interpreting and understanding the text we will be focusing on narrative writing:

To produce character and setting descriptions including the use of dialogue.

Within SPAG children will revise and develop their use of expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and direct speech.

By answering the question 'What influences did Ancient Greece have on today's society?' the children will develop their:

Knowledge of Ancient Greek culture, including myths, inventions and philosophy.

Understanding of how different Greek kingdoms lived, and the birth of democracy.

Knowledge of the conquests of Alexander the Great.

This term the children will be working on their physical skills, in particular:

Dynamic balance with agility Static balance on one leg

This term we will be studying the work of the artists Vicky Oldfield and Patrick Caulfield, using this to inspire print making using carbon paper to start, moving on to using ink and rollers. The theme of the artwork will be still lives, or everyday objects.

We will be learning about the impact that positivity has on our mental health and wellbeing.



Where Children Come First

PHSE

This term we will be discussing 'What makes up our identity?' We will look at similarities and differences between people, and understand that there are a range of factors which influence a person's identity. We will also discuss stereotypes and ways to challenge them.

Maths

Our focus in Maths this term is Place Value. We will be looking at:

Place Value

Numbers up to 1 million (reading, partitioning and ordering)
Rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
Rounding within 100,000
Finding 10, 100,1000, 10,000, 100,000 more or less
Roman numerals to 1000.

Computing

This term we will be visiting the new Computing Room to learn Word processing and how to use different computer programmes. Children will revise how to open, save and print documents. As well as copying and pasting, and using the text wrapping tool.

Religious Education

This term we are answering the question 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?' We will look at Muslim beliefs and practices, and how Muslim people worship in Britain.
