The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry The Vanishing Rainforest by Richard Platt

This term we will reading the texts based on the theme of rainforests. We will be focusing on writing persuasive letters:

- Writing two persuasive letters based on impacts human have on the rainforests.
- The features of persuasive letters
- In SPAG children will be using sequencing conjunctions and standard English.

Geography

By answering the question 'How are humans affecting the world's rainforests?' The children will develop their knowledge of:

- The world's rainforest locations
- The structure of a rainforest (biome)
- The causes and effects of deforestation
- The threats to the rainforests.
